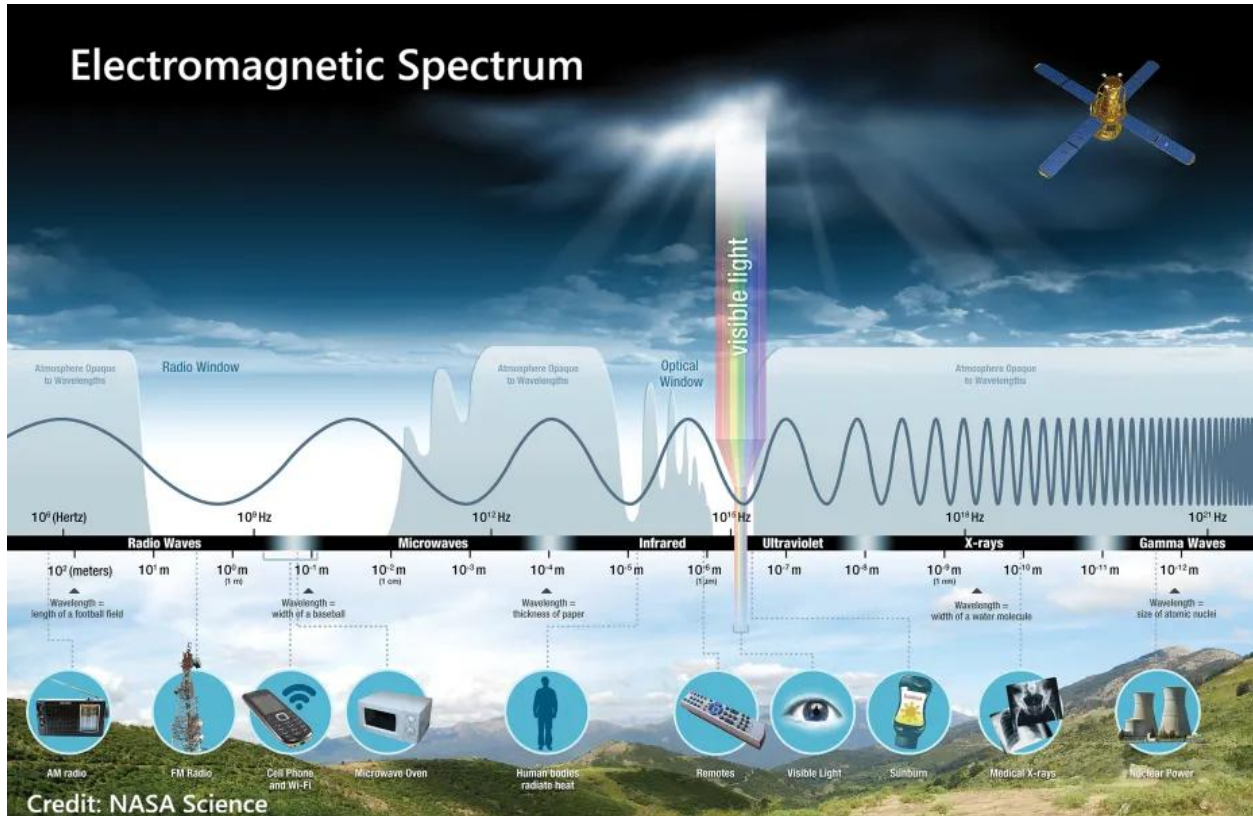


Figure 4: The Bubble Nebula, imaged by the author October 2024:

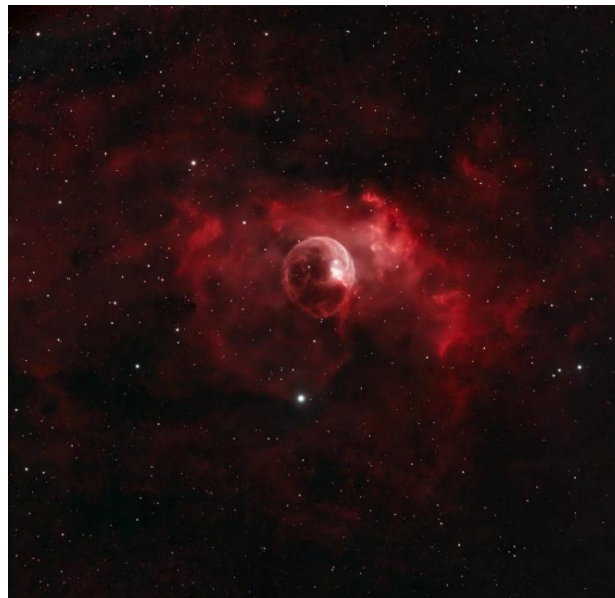


Figure 5: Human somatosensory homunculus:

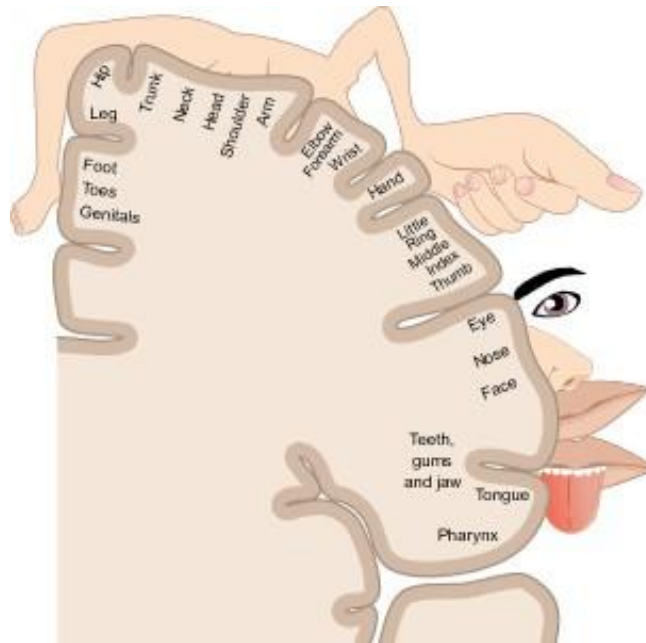


Figure 6: Visual metaphor of brain's transmissive function, AI-generated:

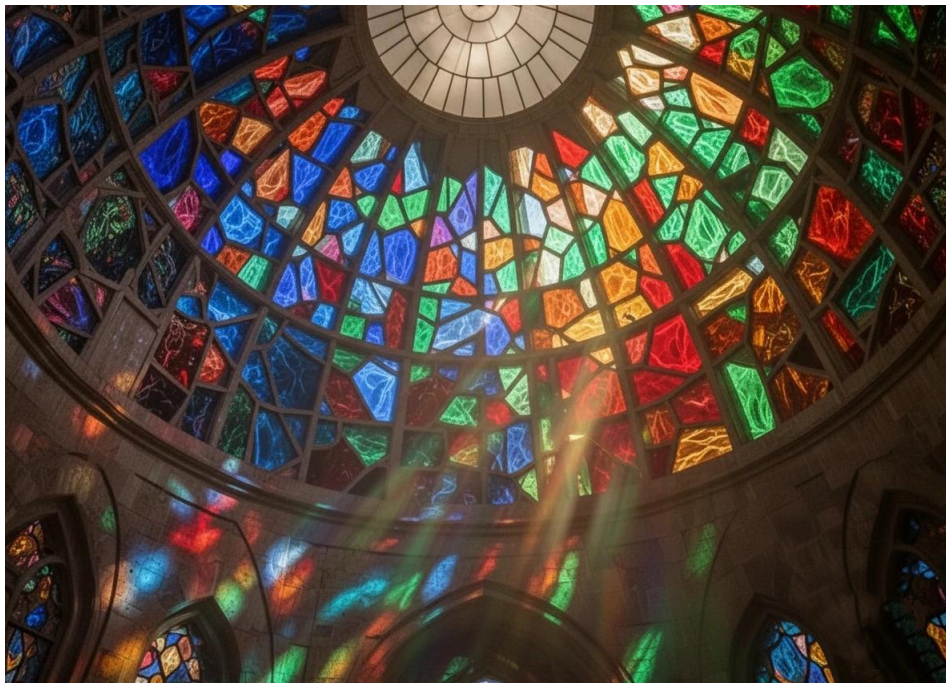


Figure 7: Normal distribution of height in American males:

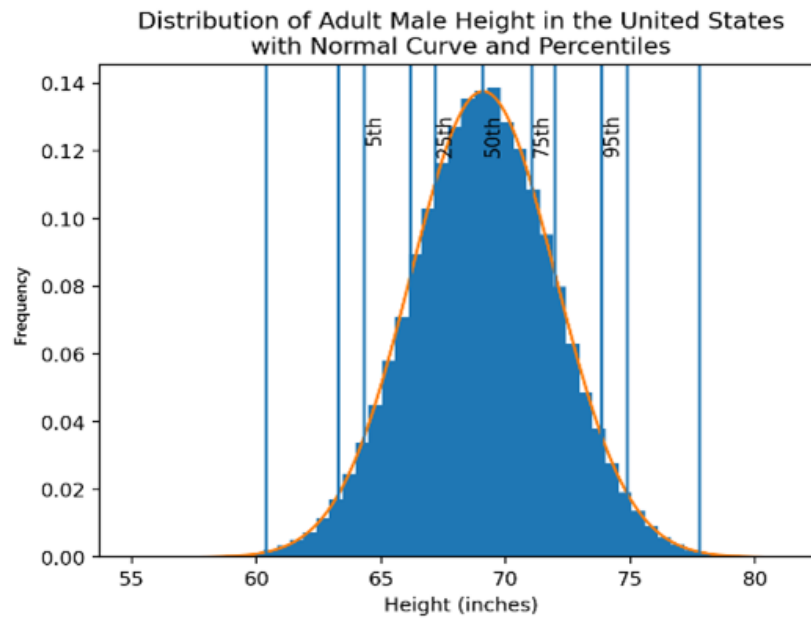


Figure 8: Photograph of incident light in a single-slit experiment. By Jordgette - Own work, CC BY-SA 3.0, <https://commons.wikimedia.org/w/index.php?curid=9529698>:

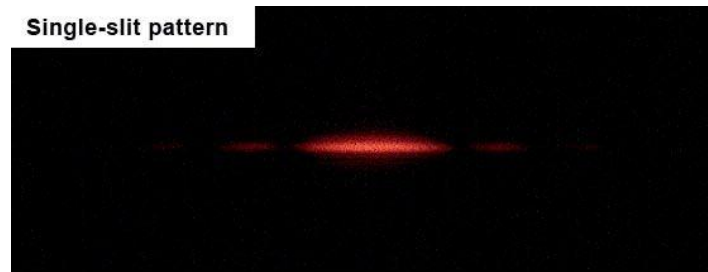


Figure 9: Interference pattern of incident light in a double-slit experiment. By Jordgette - Own work, CC BY-SA 3.0, <https://commons.wikimedia.org/w/index.php?curid=9529698>:
